They should be placed on removable foundations such as pre-cast concrete paving or blocks or railway sleepers. It is mandatory that a method is provided of collecting rainwater from the structure and it MUST be secured firmly to the ground. Please liaise with neighbours and the Site Rep before making an application.
